### 4. Public Hearing on the Continuity of Learning Plan 4.0

Mr. Michael Doney, ACPS parent, spoke about his middle school student's unsuccessful online experience during the past school year. He expressed that his student was not learning and that the amount of parent input required was excessive. Mr. Doney also questioned why an option for full-time in-school learning was not included in the ACPS back-to-school survey.

Ms. Genea Luck, ACPS parent, spoke about her first grade student's difficulty using the online learning model during the last school year. She expressed how difficult it was for young students to sit still and for teachers to keep students engaged. Ms. Luck also expressed that her student's experience in summer camp has been eye-opening, as it is very difficult for young students to keep their masks on or to social distance. She encouraged parents to volunteer to be paired with teachers to support them.

### 6. Report from Superintendent Hutchings

Dr. Hutchings thanked the staff and teachers for their efforts during the past school year using online learning. Dr. Hutchings also noted that there will be a discussion at the July 10<sup>th</sup> meeting on the Continuity of Learning Plan 4.0.
