Dear Members of the Alexandria School Board:

T.C. Williams was an arch-segregationist who did everything in his power to segregate Alexandria's black students from its white students. He was against everything for which our high school, our school system, and our community stand. It is not only unacceptable that Alexandria ever honored Williams by naming our only high school for him, but it is reprehensible that nothing has been done to change it. It is long past time to remove the name of a known racist, arch-segregationist from our city's high school.

According to Alexandria City Public School Board rules, in order to initiate the process, the School Board must receive a petition to change the name that includes the (1) the name(s) of the individual and/or group(s) making the request; (2) biographical/historical data concerning the proposed name; (3) the rationale for the request; and (4) a petition of 100 Alexandria City residents in support of the request. As we cannot just submit a petition to rename TC Williams without suggesting a new name to change it to based on these rules, we have chosen "Tubman-Chavez High School" as a placeholder.

Harriet Tubman and Cesar Chavez were incredible Americans whose names would honor our high school while allowing it to keep the initials "T.C." They would provide representation to students who do not see their heritage adequately in Alexandria schools' names. However, the renaming process must be much larger than 100 Alexandrians. We view this petition as the start of a larger conversation and urge the School Board to instruct the Superintendent to begin the process outlined in FF-R D.1 to rename T.C. Williams High School, including:

- 1) Solicitations for other nominations for naming the school.
- Community outreach and meetings across the city for discussion and nomination.
- 3) Community voting through a variety of means (i.e., in-person, online and/or written) at multiple points throughout the engagement process.
- 4) A review of the community's nominations, after which the Superintendent will formulate recommendations to the School Board for consideration.

Some additional suggestions we have heard during the petition process include Alexandria High School, Chinquapin High School, Earl Lloyd High School, Herman Boone High School, and many others. We urge the School Board to accept this petition to rename TC. and immediately begin a robust renaming process that involves the entire Alexandria community, and to eliminate T.C. Williams' name from our high school as soon as possible
